

#### Tafnit for matriculation - Beduin schools 2003/4

The program included 11<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grade students from 6 high schools who were expected to fail the matriculation exam in math based on their school performance, while passing other matriculation exams. Passing their "obstacle" subject will enable these students to gain a bagrut (matriculation) certificate.

The participating schools were mapped to identify 11<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grade students for whom math was an obstacle subject. Additional students were included to complement the study group; these students had one or more other obstacle subjects, and so may not attain matriculation even after passing the math exam.

### Follow-up on students who participated in the program in 2002/3

Among the participants of the program in 2002/3 there were 95 11<sup>th</sup> grade students from 4 Bedouin localities for whom math was an obstacle matriculation subject, according to the mapping of January 2003.

These students graduated high school in 2003/4, and 79 of them (83%) gained a bagrut certificate following their success in the math exam through Tafnit.
